WAPA Scheduled Power Outage St. Croix July 15, 2023, Affecting Portion of Feeder 7B

U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS - The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority ("WAPA" or "Authority") would like to inform customers and community members on the island of St. Croix of a scheduled outage occurring tomorrow July 15, 2023, from 7:00 AM - 3:00 PM, affecting approximately 630 customers on Feeder 7B.

630 customers will be out of service for approximately 30 minutes at the start of this window, as WAPA personnel isolate outage to perform work. Following the isolation, most customers' service will be restored, however 70 customers will remain out of service for approximately 1 hour. The purpose of this outage is to relocate 3-Phase lines near Home Depot to allow Public Works to complete a new road in Estate Clifton Hill/Melvin Evans Highway.

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About WAPA: The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority is an autonomous agency of the Virgin Islands Government which produces and distributes electricity and drinking water to residential and commercial customers in the territory. WAPA was created by the Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands in 1964 through Act No. 1248. Today, WAPA generates electrical power at production plants on St. Thomas and St. Croix and distributes electrical service through smart grids to customers on St. Thomas, St. Croix, St. John, Hassel Island, and Water Island. Potable water is distributed to almost 13,000 customers through water lines and standpipes. WAPA also has the responsibility of installing and maintaining streetlights.
