



Scheduled Electrical Service Interruption for St. Croix Customers on Feeder 8B

ST. CROIX, U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS – September 5, 2024 – The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority would like to inform customers and community members on the island of St. Croix of a scheduled electrical service interruption occurring tomorrow, Friday, September 6, 2024, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. impacting approximately 70 customers in Estate Frederikshaab on Feeder 8B. This outage is necessary to safely transfer primary and neutral wires to a new composite pole.

This work is part of the FEMA-funded Composite Pole Installation Project, designed to enhance the resilience of our infrastructure. We appreciate your understanding as we work to complete this important upgrade.

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About WAPA: The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority is an autonomous agency of the Virgin Islands Government which produces and distributes electricity and drinking water to residential and commercial customers in the territory. WAPA was created by the Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands in 1964 through Act No. 1248. Today, WAPA generates electrical power at production plants on St. Thomas and St. Croix and distributes electrical service through smart grids to customers on St. Thomas, St. Croix, St. John, Hassel Island, and Water Island. Potable water is distributed to almost 13,000 customers through water lines and standpipes. WAPA also has the responsibility of installing and maintaining streetlights.

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
