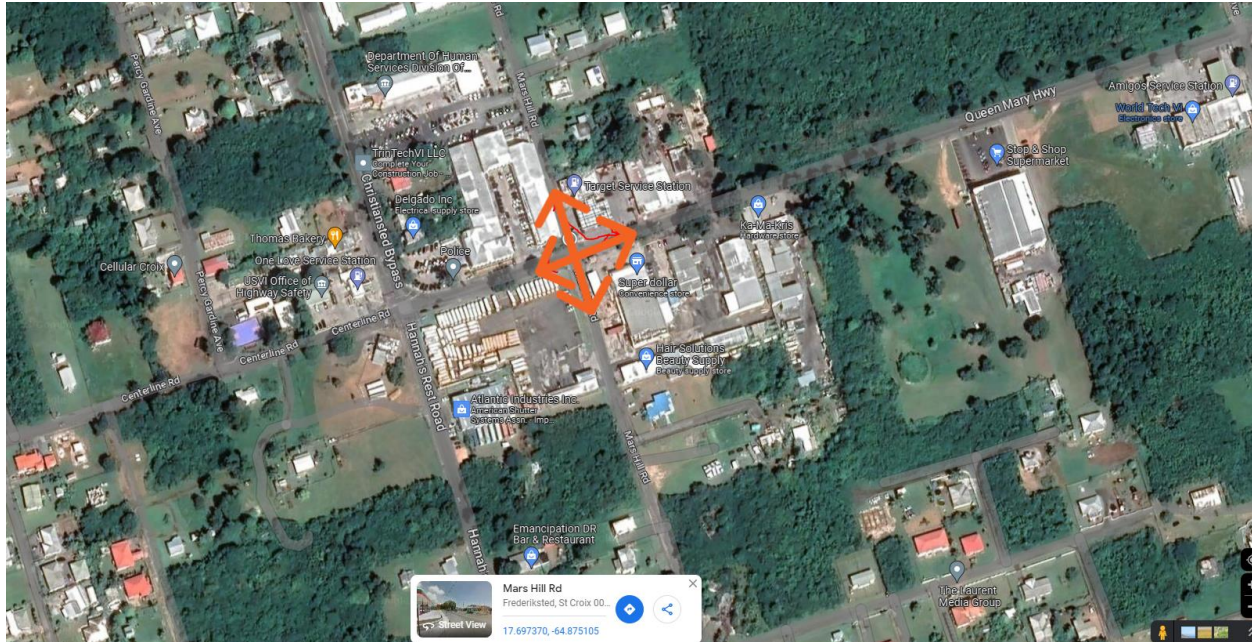


Figure 1: Orange arrows indicate where road construction will be taking place.

St. Croix - Road Construction Tomorrow August 3, 2023, Associated with Campo Rico Project

U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS – The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (“WAPA” or “Authority”) would like to advise the public of road construction on St. Croix beginning tomorrow, August 3, 2023, from 7 AM – 4 PM on Mars Hill Road between the Department of Planning and Natural Resources (DPNR) and the Target Service Station next to Centerline Road. Flagger and signage will be on site, and motorists will be rerouted through the Target gas station.

The Campo Rico Waterline Rehabilitation Project will benefit St. Croix’s Campo Rico community by improving water quality, reducing system wide water loss, and improving infrastructure and system reliability.

The Authority thanks the community for its understanding and patience, as progress towards water infrastructure upgrades continues.

About WAPA: The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority is an autonomous agency of the Virgin Islands Government which produces and distributes electricity and drinking water to residential and commercial customers in the territory. WAPA was created by the Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands in 1964 through Act No. 1248. Today, WAPA generates electrical power at production plants on St. Thomas and St. Croix and distributes electrical service through smart grids to customers on St. Thomas, St. Croix, St. John, Hassel Island, and Water Island. Potable water is distributed to almost 13,000 customers through water lines and standpipes. WAPA also has the responsibility of installing and maintaining streetlights.
