ADDENDUM I

This Addendum I to Contract SC-39-21 is hereby entered into this 11 day of August 2021 between the **VIRGIN ISLANDS WATER AND POWER AUTHORITY** (herein referred to as the "Authority") and **THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE AT CHATTANOOGA** (herein referred to as the "Contractor"). The Authority and the Contractor shall hereinafter be jointly referred to as "the Parties."

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2021, the Parties entered into Contract, SC-39-21 (the "Contract") where the Contractor agreed to provide professional services to the Authority for the purpose of performing on-site archaeological monitoring, during the construction of Feeder 7E underground duct bank in Cruz Bay, St. John, U.S. Virgin Islands. A copy of said Contract is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Appendix "A"; and

WHEREAS, Section 23 of the Professional General Contract Terms indicate that the Contract may not be amended or modified except by an instrument in writing signed by duly authorized representatives of the Parties. A copy of said Professional General Contract Terms is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Appendix "B"; and

WHEREAS, the parties seek to amend Section 5 of the Contract entitled "Business License" to reflect that the Contractor is an educational organization, which pursuant to 27 V.I.C. § 306, is exempt from obtaining a business license; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and conditions herein, the Parties, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

NH *SGR*

1. That the Preamble to this Addendum I constitute an integral part thereof;
2. That Section 5 of the Contract entitled "Business License" is amended to the following:


The Contractor, which is an educational organization, is exempt from obtaining a business license pursuant to 27 V.I.C. § 306. If applicable, however, any of the Contractor's subcontractors must comply with all U.S. Virgin Islands laws with respect to licensing which must be obtained in connection with its business operation(s). The subcontractors hired in connection with this Scope of Work shall obtain all necessary and applicable business license(s) and present copies to the Authority at the time of contract execution. Failure to present copies of license(s) shall be grounds to consider the Contract as void or the Authority may terminate this agreement.

3. That these provisions do not usurp, nor in any way change any other terms and conditions of the Contract, except as specifically stated herein.
4. That except as expressly amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Contract remain in full force and effect.
