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Temporary Power Interruption Scheduled for Feeder 4A Customers on August 6

St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands (August 4, 2026) — The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority ("WAPA" or "the Authority") advises customers served by **Feeder 4A** that a temporary power interruption has been scheduled for **Thursday, August 6, 2026, from 12:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m.**

The planned interruption is necessary to allow crews to safely replace damaged electrical equipment. Approximately 1,446 customers in the following areas are expected to be affected: **Little Princess Hill, Sion Farm, Golden Rock, Bay Garden, La Grande Princess, Tan Tan Terrace, Rattan, Constitution Hill, Sion Hill, Bellevue, and St. John.**

WAPA appreciates the understanding and support of customers as crews complete this essential work.

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About WAPA: The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority is an autonomous agency of the Virgin Islands Government which produces and distributes electricity and drinking water to residential and commercial customers in the territory. WAPA was created by the Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands in 1964 through Act No. 1248. Today, WAPA generates electrical power at production plants on St. Thomas and St. Croix and distributes electrical service through smart grids to customers on St. Thomas, St. Croix, St. John, Hassel Island, and Water Island. Potable water is distributed to almost 13,000 customers through water lines and standpipes. WAPA also has the responsibility of installing and maintaining streetlights.

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
